attached to a machine overhead. this allowed them to be warmed up, allowing the solution to curl the hair. It was a unique experience.

Growing up on a farm as a child allowed for many animals. We once had a calf born really early. It was too weak to nurse from its mother but I convinced my father to let me bring it onto the enclosed back porch and try to bottle feed it. I had to go out to the barn and milk the cow to do it She really did not appreciate this. She usually kicked the bucket several times in the process. We did save the calf. I remember the calf sucking on my fingers, at the time those brown cotton gloves were worn for chores and playing out side. She would always be happy to see us with her bottle. We also had a slew of cats. They helped keep the rats and mice down in the corn crib and barn. We had two I remember the most. One all three of us children liked, as all children, we each wanted to name the kitten. Dad suggested we combine the names, to Spotted Punkin Patcheye.

Speaking of pets, we found a pigeon with an injured leg. We had an old bird cage, to keep him in the house. We would let him out for exercise. Although he couldn't fly well, he enjoyed riding on Dad's shoulder. We had only one cat as a house pet that I can remember. I was in high school then. Dad called her Puff from the song "Puff the magic dragon," which was popular about the time.

All though I really don't remember him, we also had an orange and white long hared tom cat also. His name was Delmer. He ended up with only three legs, after he had caught one in a rabbit trap. We had him at the same time as Laddie our old faithful dog. He was a black and white border collie. He was about fifteen or sixteen when he passed away. The following winter, seven puppies were dumped in a neighbor's field. It was really cold outside. Those that no one wanted were destroyed. Our Dad picked out a black and white border collie. We named him Lucky, as he was not one of those destroyed. He was with us for another twelve Or so years.

After he was gone Dad had a brown long hared dog he called Brownie. Dad was up in years then and he had a bad hip and had a hard time getting up the steps outside. Brownie would patiently stand still so Dad could hold unto his head the push himself up the steps. When Dad passed away Mom still had the dog. He was hit by a car and his neck broken. Mike (my oldest son Michael) must have been around fifteen at the time,



he was nine years old. He lost his father before he was married. He came from a family of ten children of which four were still living when I was born. His brothers all but one suffered from the heredity disease hemophilia. Only one brother was spared this besides my Father, and he was his brother Camile. He died just like my Father, after having surgery, a blood clot hit his heart causing a massive heart attack. It is passed on through the females to the males. It has totally disappeared from our family now. The only one's who could have passed it along were my father's two sisters. Neither of them had any sons born with it. The last member to have this disease was my father's brother Alphones whom we called Uncle Pete. He passed away in about 1958, at the age of fifty one years. At the time there was no known treatment or cure for this. He lived to a remarkable age, considering the illness he had. He loved with us up to his death. At the age of seven he had a cerebral hemorrhage. This was in about 1914 and to survive this at that time in history was a miracle in itself. He was left as a severally disabled person. He was sweet and kind and quiet. I will always miss him, but I know he is in Heaven now.

My mother was three years old when she lost her father. She also had a hard life as a young child. Another person whom I loved as a child besides my grandmother, was her bachelor brother Uncle John. He lived by himself down a long lane west of Martinton on the Clifton slab just before the first of two curves that takes you over the Iroquois River. He was of a moral nature, kind, generous, and always a gentleman. He would walk to our house in all kinds of weather to visit. When we were small and it was cold out he would watch us if Dad and Mom needed to go to town. He mainly made sure none of us were hurt but that was all. We could do what ever we liked. When I was really small and he was baby-sitting, I had messed my diaper, it fell out the side. How did he deal with this, he put me a new diaper on, and put a chair over the mess till my parents returned home.

When my Dad would take us to his old house to work on something for him, we were always happy to go. Such adventures, although neglected and run down, it was so fun to explore around there. The farm is pictured in a book at Eastern Ill., University Library. It was indeed a show place. The house had a really low ceiling in the kitchen. Between the kitchen and the dinning room there was a beautiful built in cubbard that













Saturday evening there. The up-stairs then had a movie projector, and someone played the piano to accompany the silent films. He and his friends the Voss boy's and several other mischievous neighbors played many a trick there. Only to have the same type played back on him.

At his and Mom's wedding dance, it seemed several well meaning young men put my father's car up on blocks. When they attempted to leave, needless to say, the car did not respond when it was put into gear.

Father attended the Jones school. It was across the Beaver Creek to the south. The one room school was attended by the local youths, including both Dad's buddies, who were always challenging each other to fling mud balls from their shoe's to the ceiling. They would bet to see how long it would take the mud balls to dry and drop to the floor. This was one of the ways they made the teacher's head-ache medicine a necessity.

Like all youngsters the Voss boy's would rather take a short cut across the frozen creek then trudge down their long lane to Dad's road. One tragic winter day, one of the boy's fell through the thin ice, and drowned. It was several day's before they found his body. These boys were the sons of George and Martha Voss. They lived up the long lane to the south of Dad's place.

The farm originally belonged to the parents of my Great Grandma Euphemie. Their last name was Finistair. Check my family history for it. About three hundred feet back from the road in front of Dad's that was called the Renaud Road, lived Great Grandfather Ferdinand's sister. The cabin was about fifty feet back from this lane. She lived there to just about before eighteen seventy, as they are listed in the Kankakee County eighteen seventy censuses. Her name was Angelique Marie Lebrun. She was also the Great-Great-Grandmother of Dick on his Grandmother Rosalie Lebrun Regnier side. The land that this cabin was on also belonged to Ferdinand and Euphemie.

The neighbors Boehernsons to the south had a hard time keeping their fences fixed along the creek. They eventually purchased this, for additional pasture. Their son then sold it to the stupid scumbag trailer park that occupies it now.

Early record from the Papineau Road Commissioner's books shows the Renaud Road as the second official road in the township. The bridge was also called the Renaud



the hill to the north of here. It was on the east side of the road. It was a way station for the cattle drives that passed through here on their way to the Chicago stock yards. The property was bought by my father's sister, Aunt Anna and Uncle Joe Ponton. Although most of the farm buildings are gone, Leland's daughter Karen has constructed a beauty full home there now.

In the early days, before the present house was constructed, by Joseph Ferdinand Renaud (Reno) , before eighteen-eighty, Grampa Calix(his son, and my grandfather) remembers standing on the porch of their log cabin and watching the cattle drives go by. He remembered one especially when he was about nine years old.

The drover tipped his hat to grandpa, and said he was going to spend the night resting at the way station. They were observed there that evening. Some time later, he would stay there on his return. He agin was seen there by grandpa.

But later about sunset, when grandpa was rounding up the live stock to lock them up in the barn, he observed a couple. A man and a woman who worked at the way station were seen with a lantern and a wagon, just across the road. It was the present site of Leland's front yard. They were seen digging a hole and lifting something wrapped in a tarp and burying it. He was extremely scared of these rough and crude people. They were of the lowest type of seedy people. He said nothing, quietly getting home.

Several weeks later, a law official and posse stopped, asking if anyone had seen this particular individual. They were an impressive group. Their long coats were draped down over the side of their strong panting horses. You could see the butts of their hand guns peeking out on either side on their hips. Large brimmed hats, and an all business attitude with a long trip look of grime and fatigue coupled with determination. Then the missing individual was tracked all the way to the way station on his return trip after selling his cattle. All trace was lost from there. He had not returned home. Grandpa was so scared of the people from up on the hill, he never said anything, he said he feared for his life. Is this stranger what was buried in the woods that evening? This story was told to me by my Father, Dona't Louis Reno.

While working on genealogy for my father's side of the family, I had found in the 1860 census of Iroquois County the names of my great aunts and uncles. I came across
